The City shall be contacted at least twenty-four (24) hours before construction to allow scheduling of the required inspections.

No construction permittee may do any work outside the area specified in this permit.

Permit expires 60 days from date of issuance

Upon completion and within thirty (30) days after final inspection, as-built drawings shall be submitted digitally to the City. They shall be delivered as an AutoCAD drawing (.dwg) file or ArcGIS shapefile (.shp) format, and shall be projected into the following coordinate system: Missouri State Plane, NAD83 Datum, West Zone, U.S. Survey Feet. Any new facilities installed shall be GPS located with a minimum spatial accuracy of +/- three (3) feet.

The City may deny the permit to protect the public health, safety and welfare, to prevent interference with the safety and convenience of ordinary travel over the public way, or when necessary to protect the public way and its users; along with additional factors outlined in Section 10.5-132 and Chapter 10.5, Art. III. This permit is subject to the provision of Chapter 10.5, Article III of the City Code and a valid Public Ways Use Permit Agreement between owner and City.
